

# Engineering Scholarships: Support for Tomorrow's Leaders

Encouraging our exceptional students to pursue an ambitious course of study carries with it the responsibility of providing appropriate financial support. For a student living away from home, the average annual cost for one year of undergraduate education is \$15,000 and costs for professional programs, such as engineering, can be significantly higher.

**Over the next three years, the Faculty of Engineering is committed to raising \$3 million in support of graduate and undergraduate scholarships.**

- **Undergraduate Support**—Western is committed to establishing an endowment fund that will provide significant financial scholarships of \$1,000 or more per year, to support the top undergraduate engineering students with at least an 80% average or those enrolled in the concurrent degree program.

The Faculty of Engineering provides students with the unique opportunity to complete a concurrent degree in partnership with many of the faculties across campus. These unique programs allow students to graduate with two distinct undergraduate degrees in less time than it would take to complete two separate programs of study. This partnership extends to Western's prestigious professional schools including the Schulich School of Medicine, the Richard Ivey School of Business and Western Law.

- **Graduate Support**—The Ontario Graduate Scholarships (OGS) program recognizes and supports excellence in graduate studies. Under the OGS program, an expendable contribution of \$5,000 from Western alumni will leverage an additional \$10,000 in government funds to fully support one \$15,000 Ontario Graduate Scholarship award. An investment of \$125,000 will create a permanent endowment that will generate approximately \$5,000 annually, resulting in the creation of one \$15,000 OGS award per year in perpetuity.

The students enrolled in these advanced educational and research programs represent some of the brightest, most ambitious, innovative minds in any academic discipline—ones who are likely to assume leadership positions in their careers.
